We have all felt the pounding of hooves on our heads many times in life! Burning fire and overwhelming waters have threat-

But the key thought I want to highlight for you is the last few words of verse 12: "But you have brought us forth to a *spacious place*." The Hebrew word is a bit uncertain, but it appears to mean abundance, even wealth. It refers to a time of rich blessing that follows a wilderness wandering.

I am sure you can affirm with me the conviction that God has brought us all to a spacious place! Great blessing follows great trials. We learn about faith only when we have to trust, but as we trust and walk in a long obedience, God directs our steps and leads us out of a wilderness. The spacious place is Broadmoor Baptist church for many, many years to come.

Now the spacious place is not a place of ease! Even the people of Israel had to work to secure the Promised Land. And so we will work together. But we will always celebrate what God has done in our church. Let's celebrate the spacious place to which He has brought us.
