## "A Time for Looking and Remembering"

When I spoke the first Sunday of our new year, I suggested that January is a good time to look forward and remember some things. Here they are again.

**Life is a gift from God.** Live it to the fullest. You can because of your relationship to God through Christ. So many people never realize how wonderful it is to be alive, to have the gift of life, to have the gift of this day.

**Remember to worship God; love people; and use things.** It's a repeat of an earlier sermon, but still important. Try not to get these mixed up. Act in the best interest of all the people you meet—and don't forget to be an encourager.

**Don't be afraid.** All through the Bible this message comes to us, often from the mouth of Jesus. God always walks with his children. So, don't be afraid.

**Do your best—most of the time.** I don't think it's realistic to try to do your best all of the time, and it's probably not even necessary. For example, most of us have won a few arguments that would have served us and others better if we had lost them. But there will be times when your best is required—so choose

carefully when and where that is the case.

**Be grateful for every blessing.** Cicero called gratitude "the mother of all virtue." No person is so bad that they cannot appreciate sincere gratitude. We owe it to God and to people to be honestly appreciative.

**Stay positive.** It helps to keep your eyes on Christ and your head up. And it helps to try to find the good in anyone and anything. A wonderful minister and friend taught me that being positive about life and about people was a choice that I could make. Learning to have a positive attitude made life so much more fun for me, and it probably helped people to enjoy being around me a lot more too.
