Stephen was stoned to death for preaching; Phillip evangelized the Ethiopian; and Phoebe was entrusted with delivering Paul's letter to the church at Rome.

Deacons at Broadmoor are likewise fully integrated into the pastoral ministries of the church: visiting the sick, comforting the bereaved, assisting with baptisms, providing helping hands around the house, preparing food for families in stress, serving communion—at church and in homes—and providing ongoing pastoral ministry to caregivers, widows and widowers, and other targeted groups. And that's not a complete list! The work of our deacons is indeed a sure sign that ours is a Spirit filled fellowship.

Perhaps the Deacon Council Vision Statement says it best:

"Having been called to deacon service by our Lord, Jesus Christ, through the voices of the people of Broadmoor Bap-

tist Church, and having been inspired by the servant leadership of past generations of deacons, we resolve to stand firm on the foundation of His sacrifice; to build upon the legacy of our forebears; and to fulfill our mission in our day by living our lives and serving our church in a way that strengthens our bonds of faith and inspires the members of our faith community to minister to each other and to the community at large.

**Thus we proclaim our passion for Christ and our compassion for His people."**

This Sunday evening we will install 15 deacons to begin a new 3 year term, including five who will also be ordained: Jim Dasch, Frances Girod, Loretta Graham, Felix Thibault, and Dr. Christy White. I urge you to participate in the ordination service. In the tradition of the Twelve Apostles, the members of Broadmoor will ordain these new deacons by the laying on of hands. What an amazing worship opportunity! Please make plans to be there. You will receive—and you will be—a very special blessing.
