I wrote this article on Monday, but by the time you receive this in email form you are probably like me, stuck at home unable to get out during "The Great Sneaux Apocalypse of 2014." (Being from the Midwest I still marvel how the smallest sign of frozen precipitation can send South Louisianians into a lathered frenzy!) I also am mindful of the fact that if you wait 24hrs or so in South Louisiana it can go from 28 degrees to 65 or 70 degrees. Change is certain; especially in south Louisiana.

It's good to be reminded that our God does not change in terms of caring for His children. God is not cold and unloving one minute and desperately concerned about us the next. God doesn't leave us alone and afraid and then rush to be our friend. God doesn't shower us with compassion and then turn His back on us. Nothing could be further from the truth. God is ever constant and rock steady. God is faithful.

Hymns are one of the great shapers of theology for most Christians. One of my favorite hymns, *Great Is Thy Faithfulness* declares, "Great is Thy faithfulness, O God, my Father, there is no shadow of turning with Thee; Thou changest not,

Thy compassions they fail not; as Thou hast been, Thou forever wilt be. Great is Thy faithfulness! Great is Thy faithfulness! Morning by morning new mercies I see; all I have needed, Thy hand hath provided; great is Thy faithfulness, Lord unto me!" It was clear to the lyricist Thomas Chisholm that God is unchanging, God is constant.

We are also reminded from the writer of Lamentations of God's constant love, "Then I remember something that fills me with hope. The Lord's kindness never fails! If He had not been merciful, we would have been destroyed. The Lord can always be trusted to show mercy each morning. Deep in my heart I say, 'The Lord is all I need; I can depend on Him!'" The prophet knew hundreds of years ago the very thing that we can be certain of today, God's care for us is never ending.

Great politicians may come and go. The weather may change by the minute. The latest song on the radio will be "old" in a week. But our God is certain and timeless and we can count on His faithfulness to us. Can God count on ours?
