### "Broadmoor Closed the Gap"

Almost exactly a month ago I introduced you to the idea of "The Gap." As the year ends, some organizations, especially churches and non-profit agencies, talk about "The Gap" between receipts and budget goals for the year.

I challenged you to join together to "close the gap." YOU DID! Broadmoor Baptist Church gave 99.7% of its budget goal for 2012. That is an A+ on anyone's grading scale. Thank you for your faithfulness to God. During a year that contained many challenges and uncertainties in the world, you "fixed your eyes on heaven" and honored God and His church by giving generously and sacrificially.

That kind of faithfulness is so important for any church. Faithful giving enable us to reach out even further in our witness and work. To that end, the first major theme of this new year is outreach. You will be hearing and reading about Operation Antioch, which starts February 3rd. This five week, church-wide study of the first thirteen chapters of Acts will help us see how God expanded the church from Jerusalem to Antioch, and from there to "all the nations."

So "The Gap" is not only financial. It is spiritual, and we are all called to do our part as God leads us.
