## “Finishing the Journey”

*How lucky I am to have something that makes saying goodbye so hard.*

-Christopher Robin to Winnie the Pooh

Well, our 10 month journey is coming to an end, and appropriately so. After all it has been an interim. The word by definition refers to a temporary situation that should not be sustained too long.

You are about to begin a new journey with Leonard and Stephanie Ezell. You are excited about this new beginning. And no one is happier about your possibilities or more hopeful than I am about your potential.

In the original conversations about me filling your pulpit, I agreed to make the trek to Baton Rouge from January through May. In May I agreed to continue through August. By August, with word that the pastor search was close to a single candidate, the commitment was made to continue into October. For me the decisions in May and August were easy because the journey had developed into a journey with friends. I simply could not imagine *not* finishing the

journey with you.

This coming Sunday will be my last in the Broadmoor pulpit. Reflecting on this has led me to a couple of notations in Acts 20. Before leaving Troas, Paul talked so long that a listener named Eutychus fell asleep, fell out of a window and was knocked unconscious (7-12). I have no desire to put people to sleep or be the cause of harm to anyone, particularly on my last Sunday. However, I do hope to end with a word of encouragement for your continued pilgrimages of faith. In that spirit I offer to you these words from Paul spoken to the elders from Ephesus -- *And now I commend you to God and to the message of His grace, a message that is able to build you up and to give you the inheritance among all who are sanctified* (32).
