## " Enough Change!"

One year in the late eighties I wanted a globe. A globe in an office bespeaks cosmopolitanism, especially if it is in the muted brown colors. But globes were expensive and our tight budget ensured my office would continue globeless.

One year, however, Leslie made the plunge and got me just the kind of globe I wanted. It had clawfeet on the stands, metal for the supports, and of course it rotated. It also had the azimuth and several Latin phrases I did not recognize. It really look sophisticated-until you looked a little closer.

Remember the time frame, late 80's-early 90's. The Fall of the Iron Curtain. My globe still had East and West Germany. It still had the USSR for goodness sakes! No Lithuania, Latvia, or Estonia. I could have gotten this map at Dollar General.

Maps change with changing boundaries and the rise and fall of states. It's inevitable. But I am the kind of guy who really longs for consistency. I find very good news in the Bible.

The book of James reads: "Every good endowment and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights with whom there is no variation or shadow due to change" (1:17). The words

"variation or shadow" of change are astronomical terms referring to the unchanging night sky. The permanence of the stars provided comfort. By contrast, the wandering planets (from the Latin word for wander) introduced uncertainty and a comet portended doom. Change was threatening.

God, on the other hand, can be relied on. He is the Alpha and Omega, the beginning the end. He is not whimsical or capricious. He has a plan which He patiently and meticulously works out. And He has made you a part of it.

For this reason, life is not a series of uncertain and frightening events. God graciously carries you along in the river of His providence. Yes, there are swirls and eddies that can take you off course, but nothing changes the mighty course of God's will.

Babies are born with a need for order, routine, and consistency. We never outgrow those needs. Whatever you are facing in life you can trust God who is the very definition of trustworthy. He will not change on you. He is constantly for you.
