"Rest for Your Souls"

"Come to me, all you that are weary and are carrying heavy burdens, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me; for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy and my burden is light." Matthew 11:28-30

What about that phrase, "...all you that are weary and carrying heavy burdens" - I don't know anyone like that! Weary, tired, exhausted, drained, fatigued are all descriptive words which paint a dark picture of the lives of many people in our community. Calendars, cell phones and email alerts constantly pull at our attention. Then, add to that the effects of an unprecedented flood which weighs heavily on many. We are a weary people.

Jesus told us, "Come to me, all you that are wearyand I will give you rest." Yet, it is so easy for even His followers to find other ways of receiving comfort. Many times we plunge deeper into the very things that cause us stress in the first place; almost like we are attached to them. However, Jesus says, "My yoke is easy and My burden is light."

The choir has sung these words in Handel's Messiah at Christmas a number of times. The funny thing is, this piece should be sung light, free and easy with quick moving notes that fly out with a message of hope. However, it is our nature

to try to sing them like an elephant in a china cabinet. It's just about impossible to sing with that much weight in the voice. Again, we hear the words, "My yoke is easy and My burden is light."

What's the answer? Well, the scripture says, "learn from me; for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls." I'll be the first to admit I am "preaching to the choir!" Rest is not an easy commodity to come by when a lot of what you do involves, organizing, planning and preparing for the future, but the Savior offers the same answer in easy, simple terms, "learn from Me." I can admit that laughingly because I know not just Music Ministers can benefit from hearing these words of Jesus, we all can.

Terry York, Professor at Truett Seminary, offers these well resonating words, "Dear God, forgive us for ignoring the call and the yoke of the Savior. Forgive the sin of sustained weariness. Help us to accept Your deliverance from our overburdened lives." May God grant us all the strength to lay our yokes down and pick up the lighter yoke of Christ. We'll then find true rest.
