"30 Hour Famine"

"But Mommy brings us a snack." That's when I knew I was in trouble. You see, my wife was out of town for work, so I was picking up the kids from school and *I had no snack*. I tried to assure everyone that there was no need to worry because we were close to home, but they called my bluff. They knew we weren't close to home. Instantly my seven year-old became surly, my five year-old became whiny, and my two year-old began screaming in solidarity.

"I'm starving," gruffed the seven year-old. "I'm so thirsty I think I might die," whined the five year-old. The baby screamed. It had already been a long day, and we were a ways from home, so I caved. I stopped at a gas station and bought everyone chocolate milk and sugary treats, including myself.

The screaming, whining, and surliness stopped instantly. It seemed all was well with the world. On the drive home, however, it occurred to me that I had missed an opportunity to teach my children.

Were my children starving? Of course not. Were they dying of thirst? Nope. They don't know what it feels like to actually be hungry, and frankly neither do I.

We've been talking a lot about hunger this year in our youth ministry. Thankfully, our

students don't know what it feels like to be hungry, but we're learning. We've learned that 18,000 children die from hunger and preventable disease each day. We've learned that 2.8 billion people survive on less than \$2 a day and over 800 million people are chronically malnourished.

So, we've decided to do something about it. Next weekend, November 20th-21st, the students in our youth ministry will be participating in a 30 Hour Famine. The 30 Hour Famine is a fundraiser for World Vision, a ministry that seeks to alleviate extreme global poverty. We'll be fasting for 30 hours so we can better understand what it feels like to be hungry. We'll be raising money for World Vision, who will use the money raised to fight hunger around the world by teaching improved farming techniques, providing access to clean water, running malnutrition centers, and distributing emergency food supplies in disaster areas.

Here's how you can help. Pray for our students during the weekend of the fast. Consider fasting alongside us and sharing your experience with a student. You could even consider making a one-time donation to World Vision.
