Yogi is one of my favorite people of all time. I wasn't old enough to watch him play, but I do remember him coaching for the New York Mets and Yankees when I was young. I loved watching his interviews on late night TV when he was older because he made me laugh and just reminded me of the quintessential grandpa.
