As we've done the last two times, we will begin at 9:00 a.m. and share a wonderful breakfast together in the Church Activities Hall. Once we've finished, we will break up into teams to visit our church members or make phone calls to those unable to receive visits.

We firmly believe our church is a community full of compassion and grace. The *Dawnings* team is asking us to further deepen our sense of care to create a "culture of caring." I would encourage you, especially if you weren't able to attend our previous Days of Caring, to put feet and hands to that strong be-

lief. Come dialogue and connect with each other and with the people you visit.

One of the hymns we sing at Broadmoor contains the following text: *We are travelers on a journey, fellow pilgrims on the road; we are here to help each other walk the mile and bear the load. I will hold the Christ-light for you in the nighttime of your fear; I will hold my hand out to you, speak the peace you long to hear.*
