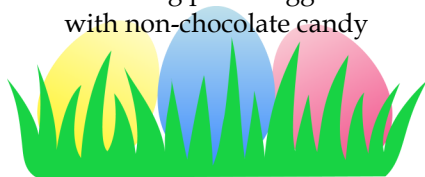

## "Loving Paradoxically"

Knowing that you would rise up in revolt if I said everything that needed to be said about a passage, I want to share with you some material that just didn't make it into the sermon last Sunday. It concerns The Golden Rule.

The Golden Rule begins "do unto others." It is positive, action-filled, and proactive. Frankly, we would be more comfortable with a negative version. "Don't do to others" means that I can sit in my corner and not worry about you. We just leave each other alone. That would be especially convenient with an unkind person. I can just ignore you.

Jesus does not give me that option. I have to reach out. I have to love, do good, be kind and gracious, even when the other person is mean and nasty! Obviously, there are limits. Only one Man gave His life for all of us. I don't have to be the second. But I can't rush to claim limits without first going the extra mile or two.

That brings me to The Ten Paradoxical Commandments. Written by Kent Keith, they illustrate the vulnerable love which we must have, and the clear expectation that not everyone will like us! They echo beautifully the commitment that Jesus had when He loved us so deeply that He endured the cross.

1. People are illogical, unreasonable, and self-centered. Love them anyway.
2. If you do good, people will accuse you of selfish ulterior motives. Do good anyway.
3. If you are successful, you will win false friends and true enemies. Succeed anyway.
4. The good you do today will be forgotten tomorrow. Do good anyway.
5. Honesty and frankness make you vulnerable. Be honest and frank anyway.
6. The biggest men with the biggest ideas can be shot down by the smallest men with the smallest minds. Think big anyway.
7. People favor underdogs, but follow only top dogs. Fight for a few underdogs anyway.
8. What you spend years building may be destroyed overnight. Build anyway.
9. People really need help but may attack you if you do help them. Help people anyway.
10. Give the world the best you have and you'll get kicked in the teeth. Give the world the best you have anyway.
