## "To the Cross and Beyond"

Anyone who has ever had children or worked with children has almost certainly heard the following expressions of frustration while traveling: "Are we almost there yet?," "How much longer," or once they get older, "Can't we just fly? I'm bored." This is all too common a response and it takes us adults almost a lifetime (if we ever get it) to see that what's equally important is not the destination (although that's usually really great) but the journey to get to that destination.

Our destination this Holy Week involves taking a journey that will carry us to the very top of our emotional spectrum as we celebrate the joy of the miracle of resurrection. But as we also know through the events described in the Bible we have to go through the pits of deep despair and hopelessness to get there. By the time Friday hits us hard, we too will be saying, "How much longer," "Are we almost there yet," "Can't we just fly?"

Broadmoor Baptist has provided many ways for you to be involved in the Journey this week. Our Education and *Dawnings* Spirituality Committees have worked together to provide great times of personal reflection and renewal by hosting a daily prayer walk Sunday through Wednesday. anytime from 6-7p.m. Maundy Thursday Evening there is an opportunity to be involved in fellowship, and also experience, through communion and scripture, the events leading up to Good Friday. The darkest day of the Journey remains Good Friday. At 7 p.m. we will recall some of the most painful and bleak events in history as we remember the crucifixion and death of our Lord Jesus. It isn't fun, but there's no way to get to Easter without it. Finally, Sunday comes and we celebrate with beautiful flowers on the cross, wonderful food and fellowship, and of course, glorious music and worship!

Come and experience all that you can. It's a long and at times painful road we'll travel this week. But we'll travel it together as families do, and come out on the other side stronger and empowered to live as the resurrection people we're supposed to be.
