



“Team Effort”

Let us consider how to provoke one another to love and good deeds, not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another..... (Hebrews 10:24-25)

Congratulations to Patrick Reed, graduate of U High, for winning the 82nd Masters Tournament last weekend. Winning at that level is no small feat. The pressure, I hear, is unbearable and severe. Dave Marr admits, “At my first Masters, I got the feeling that if I didn't play well, I wouldn't go to heaven.” Roger Maltbie says, “By the time I got to the first tee in my first Masters, I was so scared I could hardly breathe.” When Australian Adam Scott won the Masters Tournament in 2013, he credited the fans, saying, “I felt there were a lot of Australians out there all week, but incredible support from everyone in the crowd. I really felt they were on my side. . .”

You may or may not be fans of golf, but you know what it's like to face adversity. You know what it's like to have the breath scared out of you. You know what it's like to want to give up. In times like these, we need our fans cheering us on. Hebrews 10 says the key to persevering under pressure is the cheers from our church. We need our commu-

nity to help us on our Christian walk. And we need to be the fans encouraging folks facing adversity.

This requires us to pay attention to those around us, to recognize when others need a helpful word. It also requires us to show up for them, to be there for our community; and in the context of Hebrews 10, to show up for church, for Sunday school, for worship. We need one another, but if we “neglect to meet,” we cut off that holy opportunity. We are a team. We are a “church team.” Sometimes we need the cheers of our church, and other times we need to be fans cheering.

When my youngest brother was in high school, I attended one of his track meets. He was a long-jumper, and better than his oldest brother. As he prepared to jump, I stood at the end of the sand pit. He could see me cheering him on, and he broke the school record. The reason he jumped so far, he said, “because you were with me.” May we show up for one another, encouraging and cheering “to love and good deeds.”
