“Listen for your Calling”

Pardon the interruption. I know you have a lot going on. But I have a question. Isn't there something you are supposed to do with your life?

Os Guinness writes of a prominent businessman who spoke to a conference in London. “As you know,” he began, “I have been very fortunate in my career and I’ve made a lot of money - far more than I ever dreamed of, far more than I could ever spend, far more than my family needs.” At this point he paused. He was a very strong man, determined in character, highly motivated, and focused. Yet beneath the facade of intensity and assurance a basic uncertainty and doubt troubled him. A single tear rolled slowly down his well-tanned cheek. He continued, “To be honest, one of my motives for making so much money was simple - to have the money to hire people to do what I don’t like doing. But there’s one thing I’ve never been able to hire anyone to do for me; find my own sense of purpose and fulfillment. I’d give anything to discover that.”

It’s one of the ultimate questions that you will need to ask yourself in life. “Why am I here? What is my purpose?” You, like the businessman, may come to a crisis when you realize that you would give anything to discover your purpose and live a life with meaning. Honestly, it’s not that difficult.

Jeremiah protested God’s call by claiming that he was too young (Jer. 1:1-10). But God told him that He formed him in the womb, knew him, and had a plan for him. Over Jeremiah’s objections God reassured him that He would take care of him. Jeremiah simply had to trust God. That is your task also.

And please don’t make the mistake of assuming the notion of “calling” is only for some higher class of Christians. God offers everyone a role in His plan. It’s part of our shared glory. We all have a part to play.

The specific expression really does not matter. You fulfill God’s role for your life, your calling, by loving Him and loving the people around you. Not always easy, but neither is it complex.

So go and pursue your calling after reading this little column. It’s what you were created to do.
