“Which Window Do You Look Out?”

Catherine Marshall wrote in Christianity Today about her friend Marge who was in a plane waiting for takeoff to Cleveland. As she settled in she noticed through the windows on one side of the plane a beautiful sunset, the entire sky filled with glorious color. Through the window on the other side of the plane, however, the sky was dark and threatening as a storm approached.

Marge said that at that moment it was as if God spoke to her. “You have noticed the windows. Your life, too, will contain some happy, beautiful times, but also some dark shadows. Here’s a lesson I want to teach you to save you much heartache and allow you to abide in me with continual peace and joy. You see, it doesn’t matter which window you look through; this plane is still going to Cleveland. So it is in your life. You have a choice. You can dwell on the gloomy picture. Or you can focus on the bright things and leave the dark, ominous situations to Me. I alone can handle them anyway. The final destination is not influenced by what you see and hear along the way. Learn this, act on it and you will be released, able to experience the peace that passes understand-

ing.” (PT.com comfort, from CT, 5/15/95)

In Isaiah’s day the people had developed the habit of only looking at the storm. They had forgotten about the God who loved them, will renew their strength, and lift them up on the wings of eagles (Isa. 40:31). That knowledge did not solve their problem, but it re-awakened their hope.

You see, the challenge of the Christian faith is to make a choice in what you believe. I think this is the most overlooked aspect of faith. You have to make a choice as to what you believe. Most people do not realize this. They think that belief in anything is a simple matter of indisputable truth. When presented with a set of facts, people will naturally believe. Not true. You must make a choice to believe.

What do you choose to believe this week? Which window will you look out? Do you see only the storms and problems? Or do you also see the bright promises of hope and assurance. Make the choice of looking for the blessings. Let God handle the storms.
