When I was a boy, my friends and I played a "magic" trick. The idea was to lift one of your friends off the ground using only two fingers! Now, of course, no magic is involved in this at all. Frankly, it's something even more exciting, called physics. Six people distribute the weight.

While there is no magic involved, this simple trick does illustrate an important spiritual truth. When life tumbles in and you are down God will put people in your life that can lift you up. You must learn to look for these people and listen to the voices that will help you rebuild your life.

In the Scripture, Paul had Timothy. David had Jonathan. Even Jesus had the company of the disciples, and though they failed Him in some important ways, you still get the impression from scripture that He wanted and needed their companionship.

This principle is clear in Psalm 3. David wrote this when he was fleeing from enemies. Beleaguered, depressed and hounded, David felt life was tumbling in. But he was not hopeless. Verse 3 is the key: "But Thou, O Lord,

art a shield about me, my glory, the lifter of my head." I like that last phrase, "the lifter of my head." God reaches down and gently lifts our heads from the dust in which we have fallen. He restores and protects. That is the way God works.

But God often uses other people to come and lift us up. Think about some tremendous challenge you have faced. How did you survive? What helps you now? Chances are you can think of someone who was there for you, encouraging you with a phone call, a visit. In some way that friend lifted you up. The writer of Ecclesiastes observed this truth of human relationships. "Two are better than one . . . for if they fall, one will lift up his fellow." (4:9-10)

So be a lifter of people this week. One of the very best prayers you can pray is "God, give me someone to help today." Or if you find yourself in need, then look for the people God has placed in your life. Listen to them and rely on them. They will lift you up.
