## "After Easter Benefits"

This is the Monday after Easter. What lingering, even life-changing effect, should I be experiencing? Surely the holiest day of the Christian year should make a difference in the way I live on Monday.

In Philippians, Paul wrote of "Knowing Him and the power of His resurrection" (3:10). This is what I'm aiming for. Continually knowing the power of His resurrection. The resurrection is not simply an historical event we commemorate like Columbus Day, it is a life-transforming experience. We know more deeply the presence of the risen Christ. What He promised, that His going away would benefit us, we can experience each day. Each Easter is a reminder. So what benefits can we expect?

First, the work of the Holy Spirit becomes more warmly real to us. Jesus connected His departure to the special arrival of the Holy Spirit (see John 14-16 especially). I need to know the Holy Spirit better. He is mysterious, a divine wind that blows gently or powerfully through our lives. I do wish to get to know the Spirit better. He reminds us of Jesus' teaching, comforts, encourages, and warns. I need all of these, and

can live closer to the Spirit the Monday after Easter.

Second, any residual fear of death is lessened. I don't suppose anyone can honestly say they have no lingering fear of death. Death is so dark, sometimes so painful, the ultimate physical expression of sin, that we cannot possibly dismiss it as a reality. However, in the New Testament that is practically what happens. Paul knew that to live is Christ, but to die is gain (Phil. 1:21), still I doubt he looked forward to the chopping block.

The Christian advantage here is that we know what is on the other side, and even though the details are lacking (I doubt we could comprehend them) the big picture is thrilling. "We shall see Him as He is, and we shall be like Him" (1 John 3:2).

Death is not a negligible experience. It hurts those left behind. But the sting of death has been removed for those who cross over. Easter is proof of that. It's annual promise is powerful enough to overcome the doubts of the rest of the year.
