



"Block Party for Jesus"

The *Pauses for Lent* devotional word for today, Monday, April 03, 2017, is "Service." In Matthew 20:28, Jesus said, "The Son of Man came not to *be* served but to *serve*." I find this a fitting thought following our neighborhood block party last Saturday as I witnessed forty or fifty of our BBC folk, decked out in our light blue "Block Party Host" t-shirts, *servicing*. We put together a Broadmoor Baptist Church booth, complete with goodie-bags, service times, candy, and bottles of water. We served cold soft-drinks, set up tables and chairs for exhibitors, hauled and set up heavy stage pieces, set out trash cans, supervised the giant slide, arranged for exhibitors and children's activities, and spent time welcoming our neighbors. And then, when it was all over, we did these in reverse. We did it as a church family, out of sense of service to our neighbors, welcoming the stranger as Christ, for Christ, as He said in Matthew 25:35-40:

"For I was hungry and you gave Me something to eat, I was thirsty and you gave Me something to drink, I was a stranger and you invited Me in, I needed clothes and you clothed Me, I was sick

and you looked after Me, I was in prison and you came to visit Me." "Then the righteous will answer him, 'Lord, when did we see You hungry and feed You, or thirsty and give You something to drink? When did we see You a stranger and invite You in, or needing clothes and clothe You? When did we see You sick or in prison and go to visit You?' "The King will reply, 'Truly I tell you, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for Me.'"

It has been said that "nothing should be done for the first time," meaning that the first attempt at anything always reveals room for improvement. And while there is always room for improvement, word on the street is that it was a terrific party: fun music, precious pets, delicious hot dogs and ice cream, smiling children, perfect weather, and inspiring *service*. I'm looking forward to next year's block party!
