"The Monday After Easter"

Ever wonder about the Monday after Easter? The disciples were still trying to wrap their minds around the events of the previous day. "Did that really happen?" "What does this mean?" What was that Monday like?

What was your Monday after Easter like? Has the newness and the thrill already dimmed? Has life once again conspired to drag you down? More to the point, has your response to life dragged you down?

I want an enduring Easter. What might that look like?

Ken Chafin is one of the great names in our denomination. He wrote of attending Holy Week services all week and then taking a twenty-four hour period by himself to think about Jesus' sacrifice and resurrection. He wanted to go deeper and had the feeling that God would perhaps reveal something more to him. And finally, it dawned on him that God wanted to relieve him of some things that were bogging him down. That's how He brings life to us. He takes away things that bring death.

In Dr. Chafin's words: "He said, 'Kenneth, you're a

little frightened; let Me take your fear. Through the years, you've accumulated people that don't like you. You've let that bother you. Let Me take that away from you. Let Me take away your defensiveness and insecurity and bring to you a sense of peace, of boldness, of love, of forgiveness, of openness, and the willingness to risk.'

"So I said to God: 'This is what I want at Easter, for the living Christ to come and take out of me everything that's deadly; deadly to others and deadly to myself.'"

Too often we hold on tightly to the very things that make us spiritually sick. Anger, resentment, fear, pride, self-pity are soul-corrosive. These deadly attitudes to life can take the thrill out of anything, even Easter.

Why not pray for Christ to help you live in the power of His resurrection? Ask Him to take all those spirit-draining habits from you. He will, or at least take from you the ones you're ready to release. Then you can live fully on the right side of Easter.
