"But My servant Caleb . . . has a different spirit and has followed Me fully." Numbers 14:24

A brief study of Caleb brings wonderful lessons for growing in Christ and daily experiencing the gracewaves God sends your way. I love the scene in Numbers where Caleb stood up, silenced the fearful doubters and said, "we should go up and possess the land, for we can surely do it!" (Num. 13:30). What made Caleb different?

First, Caleb was not afraid to be in the minority. All Christians have a "different spirit," because of the presence of Christ, but not all of us are willing to be in the minority which makes us truly different. Our growth in Christ is a daily challenge and a long journey of obedience in the same direction. The further along we go, the fewer people we see. Deep faith is a rare gift.

Only Caleb and Joshua believed they could conquer Canaan. Two of twelve, a small minority. Don't be surprised when your commitment to God puts you in the minority, but don't ever be a silent minority! Stand up graciously for what you believe God has called you to do. Don't ever sacrifice truth for popularity or acceptance. You may not have a great throng following you, but as God rewarded Caleb for his determined commitment, He will honor and bless you.

Second, Caleb's difference was due to following the Lord fully. Another translation is "wholeheartedly," and we find that word used to describe Caleb's faith four times in the Bible. He had determined in his heart that he could trust God completely, and based on that complete trust he was willing to go out on a limb for God.

Caleb was able to look at the obstacle of taking the land through the lens of God's power and provision. You will face an obstacle in your life that appears to be overwhelming. Good for you! That is a time when God can show you His power and provision. You will not learn wholehearted commitment apart from that challenge. Will you trust God fully and follow through on that commitment? The obstacle may be teaching a class, performing a ministry, making a sacrifice for God, or simply staying faithful in daily commitment. The obstacle will appear overwhelming, but it is not too big for God!

Learn from Caleb, and have a different spirit.
