One of my favorite people in the world is Mr. Fred Rogers, the creator of *Mister Rogers’ Neighborhood*. Did you know that he wrote every one of the 905 episodes of *Mister Rogers’ Neighborhood*, along with 200 songs that were featured in the show? Or that he was an ordained Presbyterian Minister, who earned a Master of Divinity while taking classes at Pittsburgh Theological Seminary during his lunch break? Or that he had his car stolen once, only to have it returned two days later with a note saying, “We didn’t know it was yours.”

He once said that the space between a person’s mouth and a child’s ear is holy ground. That idea has influenced the way I speak to children. It has caused me to cherish every word that I choose to occupy that holy space. It has also shaped the way that I view my time spent with them. Rather than seeing my time with children as a task or a burden, I’ve begun to see it as an opportunity to stand in a holy space.

This summer we will be offering a Vacation Bible School at Broadmoor. VBS isn’t just an event for chil-

dren; it’s an event that provides adults with the opportunity to stand in a holy space and to fill that space with words and experiences of grace and love.

We need volunteers to make VBS happen. We need people to lead the following stations: Music and More, Bible Exploration, Wilderness Games, and Projects-with-a-Purpose. We also need volunteers to lead our kiddos from station to station, decorate the rooms for VBS, provide childcare for children too young to attend VBS, and to be a photographer for the weekend.

VBS will run from Friday, July 21st from 6:00-8:00 and Saturday, July 22nd from 2:00-4:00. Following the worship service on Sunday we will have a lunch for our VBS families and volunteers to close out the weekend.
