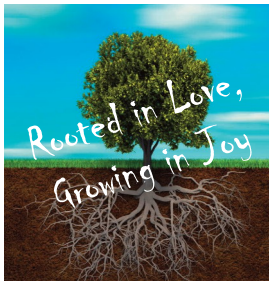

“Live With Confidence”

"If you have been raised with Christ, seek the things that are above, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God." Col. 3:1

One quality of the major figures in the New Testament is that they possessed a remarkable calm even though the world around them was full of uncertainty. Colossians is one of the prison epistles, written by Paul during one of his multiple incarcerations. Though his circumstances were nearly chaotic by our standards, Paul wrote with soaring themes and obvious conviction.

What enabled him to have such confidence and to seek the things above?

Paul was certain that no circumstance either baffled or bewildered God. We love to have control over our lives, and in many respects we do, but the exceptions are sure to come. At certain points we learn that we have an illusion of control, and life can spin away in unanticipated ways. Instead of over-reacting to those breakouts of chaos let them trigger in you a renewed focus on God. He is not surprised by any event in your life.

The 24 hour news cycle and the insatiable yearning for higher ratings creates a sense that the world is spinning out

of control. Think about it for a moment. Is the world today more chaotic than it was in the first century? I doubt it. And whatever the state of the world, God is still God (which means you are not). You were not intended to have control. God created you to trust Him.

A second vital quality Paul possessed was a drive to serve other people. He lived for a cause far beyond his personal desires or vision. His calling from God possessed him and drove him to focus on other people.

If you attempt to create your own happiness, you will miss it every time. Happiness is not your goal, neither are peace, joy, security, etc. All of these wonderful qualities are by-products of a life lived in service to others. Make a goal this week to serve other people. Seek ways to lift the burdens of other people. You will gain an immeasurable blessing.

Live with confidence today by looking to God and drawing strength from Him to serve other people.
