## “Witnesses in Jerusalem”

“...and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.”

Spoken by the risen Christ immediately before His ascension into heaven and recorded in Acts 1:8, this verse is well known in evangelical circles and has often been used among Baptist congregations to promote offerings for foreign missions during the Christmas season. Baptists have been supporting missionaries around the world so well and for so long that “doing missions” has become part of our DNA.

But let’s look a little deeper into the text. How did this verse resonate with the disciples? What did “be my witnesses” mean? Repeatedly, as He performed miracles, Jesus admonished the person who was healed NOT to talk about it. So now, is He telling the disciples to tell His story? It seems so. And what, exactly, was the Jesus story? For the disciples, it was really very simple: “this Jesus, whom you crucified, is the Messiah.”

So what does this verse mean for us? We do a great job of sending missionaries to foreign lands, supporting ministry and mission work in Lake Providence, and providing funds and volunteers for Southeast Ministries. Is that it? Are we done? Can we check off that box on the

Kingdom of God admissions form?

I invite you to focus on the first part of the verse: “And you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem.” What does that mean? How are we to witness? How are we to tell the Jesus story? Does “witnesses” apply to each of us as individuals? As a congregation? Do we simply live good lives and hope someone notices? Are we called to stand and speak at every opportunity? Are we to practice Christian devotions in public so that all may know whom we serve? Bumper stickers? T-shirts? Tattoos?

And where is our Jerusalem? Is it Baton Rouge? Is it Broadmoor subdivision? Is it the neighborhood where each of us lives? Is it your workplace? Your gym? Your yoga class? Could it be all of the above?

Here’s the answer: it’s not for me to say. It’s for you to find out. What are your gifts? What is the best way you can tell the Jesus story? And where is your Jerusalem? Seek and find the answers to those questions and you will learn why you were born. Be blessed.
