As long as I wall off any part of my life from His presence, as long as I fail to give my very best for God, then I sentence myself to a life of frustration and mediocrity. I can skim the surface of the Christian faith, but without sacrifice I will never plunge deeply into eternal life.

We all must come to a moment of reckoning when we decide (again) to stop giving God the scraps of our lives, and instead give Him our all. It's time to leave behind half-hearted commitments and convenient faith. It's time to give God complete access to every part of our lives, and make our lives a living

sacrifice to Him.

On His altar we place the very best of our lives, our deepest devotion, our most sincere desires, our highest loyalty, our time, our money, our all.
