A well-established Jewish tradition says that there are 613 commandments in the Torah. They range from the obvious to the obscure. There are a lot of commandments and a lot of ways to break the commandments. In biblical times, in order to make sure everyone followed the commandments to the best of their ability, a career opportunity was created: the expert in the law.

Once, an expert in the law asked Jesus, as a way of trapping Him, which of the 613 commandments was the most important. Jesus replied, “Love the Lord your God with all your heart, and all your soul, and all your mind.” And then He added, “Love your neighbor as yourself.” According to Jesus, all of the law and the prophets hang on these two commandments.

In that moment Jesus simplified the rules; He distilled them down to what was most important. As a part of the *Dawnings* initiative, some of us have been meeting to discuss what it might look like for Broadmoor to be more intentionally focused on doing these things.

We intend on inviting people to our campus to attend fun community oriented events so that we can meet our neighbors and begin cultivating relationships with them. These are low-key, non-threatening ways for us to introduce ourselves.

One of these outreach events will be held on Saturday, July 16th. We will be inviting our neighbors to a community block party. We’ll provide food, music, and fun. This will be a great way to connect our church’s neighbors and begin to learn more about how we can be a good neighbor, showing the love of Christ to our community. I hope you will make plans to come, wear a smile, and extend your friendliness to those we welcome to our church that day!

During the sweltering months of June and July, comfortable and casual dress is encouraged for Sunday School and Worship.

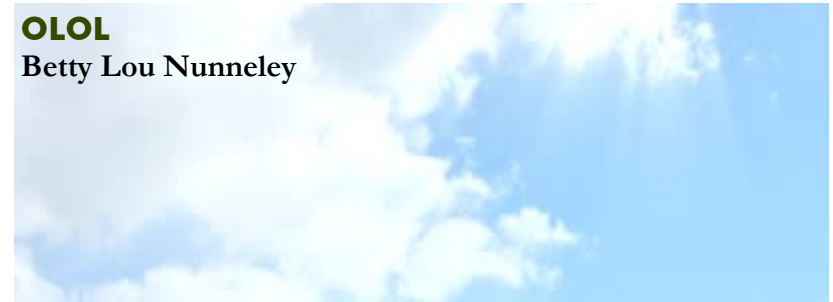
Help Needed!
