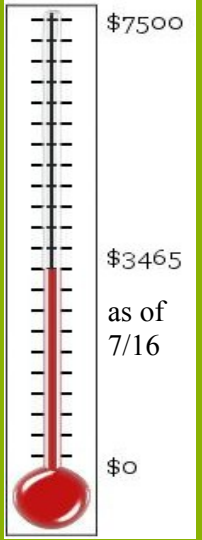

"Life is a Test"

In his first letter, Peter alerted his readers that they were in for a test. His words will help you in the tests you are facing today.

"Do not be surprised at the fiery ordeal that comes upon you." (4:12) Some Christians retain the idea that being faithful enough ensures they will not face difficult times. If you believe that, then you need to re-read the Bible, and this time to pay attention! Every faithful character in scripture faced tremendous challenge. So if you are reading this you are either facing a test, or about to face another test. Do not be surprised. Tests are part of life.

"In this you rejoice, though now for a little while you may have to suffer various trials" (1:6). Tests are varied but limited. When you are in the middle of a test remember the "little while" part. It usually does not go on forever. Also notice the connection of joy and test. Have you reached the point where you can rejoice in the trial? Few Christians have, but to do so is a tremendous step forward. Facing a test is the surest way to see God's presence in your life.

"For to this you have been called, because Christ also suffered, leaving you an

example" (2:21). You are a follower of Christ. Part of that commitment means enduring challenge and difficulty the same way He did. He remained faithful. He did not blame or suspect God was inadequate. In the middle of a test, you may feel God has let you down. While understandable to a point, you must not embrace this idea. Face adversity with faith.

A test accomplishes two things. First, it reveals what you know. It can affirm your faith. Second, a test reveals what you still need to learn. A test can be a teaching tool and occasions of great growth as God reveals His faithfulness in your challenge.

So as you face today's test, do not despair. God has not forsaken you. In fact, He has a purpose, even in your pain.
