This summer the youth of Broadmoor Baptist had the opportunity to attend Passport Missions in Greenville, SC on the beautiful campus of Furman University. Broadmoor Baptist was well represented by an amazing group of youth of which you should be proud. I would also like to thank our chaperones, Chris and Nita Hannie, and Kelli Rayburn. They were a blessing to our kids and our kids were a blessing to them and many others.

The theme for this year was “Enough”, based on 2 Corinthians 12:9a (CEB), "He said to me, 'My grace is enough for you, because power is made perfect in weakness.'" This verse reminds us as followers of Jesus that Christ's grace is truly enough for all of us.

We also learned about the beautiful Roma people across Europe and important work happening with this outcast people group who has been unwelcome in many parts of the world for centuries. We learned about

systematic discrimination in Eastern Europe that has left the Roma vulnerable to the long-term effects of little access to education, the inability to own land, or have recognized rights as citizens.

Some questions we have encouraged our youth to ask of themselves are the same questions each we can also ask of ourselves...

- How do you think God sees you?
- When do you need a reminder of how God views you?
- When and why do you need a reminder that God loves you?
