“Endurance”

Endurance was the name of a ship that Sir Ernest Shackleton and 27 other men were on when their expedition became stranded in the ice flow of Antarctica in 1914. The story is a compelling tale of survival. All 28 members of the expedition survived, endured life on the shifting ice for over a year even as their ship was crushed. The ship named *Endurance* did not survive. The *Endurance* did not endure. The last men to sail on it did.

The word *endurance* means to undergo suffering, and to continue to exist. Many students have *endured* my lectures (some by sleeping). Many church folks have *endured* my preaching (some by sleeping). Speaking of sleeping, who has *endured* a few sleepless nights along life’s journey?

I have heard a number of southeast Louisiana flood victims testify that they will survive. Some saying, “We have no other choice. Lost it all. We will start over.”

However, it is hard to imagine anyone intentionally choosing to go through the experience of these floods. If anyone had the knowledge, the power to avoid the devas-

tation, to stop the impact of torrential rising waters – wouldn’t they choose to use that power?

“I stand amazed in the presence of Jesus of Galilee” – who “*endured* the cross” so that I might endure the flood waters of life without drowning - in order that I might be rescued to the new life of eternity. And Jesus had the power to avoid the crucifixion. He also had the love that compelled Him to *endure* it.

A friend this past Sunday with excellent exegesis gave the text of Psalm 29:10 the correct emphasis: “The Lord sits enthroned **OVER** the flood.” And the writer of Hebrews claimed Jesus *endured* the cross and “has taken His seat at the right hand of the throne of God.” (Hebrews 12:2)

This gives me hope and a reason to return to worship with you this coming Sunday!
