## "A Few Reminders from The Ark of the Covenant"

The most important furnishing of the Tabernacle was The Ark of the Covenant. The word ark simply means "box," and this box was only about 4 feet long, 2 ½ feet wide, and 2 ½ feet deep, built of acacia wood, overlaid with gold, and ornately decorated. Specifically made to be mobile like the tabernacle itself, it was the central symbol of God's presence among His people. Its fate has been the focus of intense speculation and even a movie or two. Most likely it was taken by the Egyptians during one of their wars with Israel.

The most fascinating aspect of the Ark for me is the contents. The Ark itself reminded people of God's abiding presence. The contents reminded people of God's blessings. The Ark contained four objects: the two tablets of the law, a jar of manna, and Aaron's rod. What is their significance? Why did God want these three objects in the Ark?

The law gives us God's direction for our spiritual development. It governs our thoughts and conduct, but also leads us to realize our need for grace.

The manna reminds of God's provision. He always meets our needs. Remember God only provided each day's

worth of manna. The people could not store up manna for the future. They had to trust God's daily provision, just as you need to trust Him for your daily bread.

The rod reminds us of God's guidance. The people followed the leader who carried that rod and eventually found their way to freedom and blessing. Jesus called Himself the good shepherd. You can trust Him to lead you.

Though the Ark disappeared more than 2500 years ago, God's promises associated with the symbols in the Ark never diminish. Through Christ, God dwells within you! You are God's temple! And through God's presence you will: (1) know how to think and act; (2) remember that God always provides for your needs; and (3) know that God has a purpose and will give direction to your life.

Do not neglect God's presence within you. He is there to help you grow, give you confidence, and help you live with purpose and meaning.
