"Singing Praises"

On Sunday, June 21, the Broadmoor Baptist Church congregation will experience a special service of worship centered entirely on music. While Pastor Ezell is on sabbatical, he requested that we dedicate one Sunday to worship through music rather than inviting a guest preacher. We are grateful for this opportunity to offer our gifts in praise and to reflect on God's presence through song and instrumental music.

The Sanctuary Choir, joined by the Broadmoor Brass and members of Belles et Beaux, will present a service entitled "Singing Praises." Throughout the morning, a variety of musical offerings will lead us in worship, reflection, and celebration.

The Broadmoor Brass will present *Glory Bound*, an uplifting medley featuring beloved hymns including *When We All Get to Heaven, I'll Fly Away*, and *When the Roll Is Called Up Yonder*. Special guest musicians joining the brass ensemble include trumpeter Lillian Duvall, BBC member, and Steven Cozulli, a doctoral student at Louisiana State University.

Longtime handbell players Sandy Purdom and Barbara Broome will perform Barbara's original arrangement of *The Lord's Prayer*, accompanied by Dr. Rowe at the piano. The service will also feature a small vocal ensemble presenting Heather Sorenson's moving arrangement of *Nearer, My God, to Thee*.

The Sanctuary Choir will offer four anthems during worship:

- *Crystal River* (arr. Heather Sorenson)
- *Heaven Crowned Him, Christ the King* (Pepper Choplin)
- *This Is My Father's World* (Elaine Hagenberg)
- *Like a Mighty Wind* (Karen Marrolli)

Crystal River is a folk-inspired setting that combines the traditional Welsh tune *Calon Lân* with rich contemporary harmonies, creating vivid musical imagery of God's cleansing grace. This anthem has become a favorite among members of the Sanctuary Choir.

This Is My Father's World is based on the beloved hymn text by Presbyterian minister Maltbie D. Babcock, whose poetry celebrates God's presence throughout creation. First published in *The School Hymnal* in 1899, the text continues to inspire worshipers with its timeless message of faith and wonder.

Karen Marrolli's *Like a Mighty Wind* features a soaring melody and heartfelt text that invites the Holy Spirit to move through us in acts of love and service. Marrolli, who earned her Doctor of Musical Arts degree from Louisiana State University in 2010, currently serves as Director of Music Ministries at Central United Methodist Church in Albuquerque, New Mexico.

In *Heaven Crowned Him, Christ the King*, Pepper Choplin pairs an original melody with the cherished hymn *All Hail the Power of Jesus' Name*, creating a powerful proclamation that Christ is the King of kings and Lord of lords.

Many of the musical selections throughout the service will be accompanied by piano, violin, and cello, adding depth and beauty to this unique morning of worship.

We invite you to join us for this special service as we gather to worship, reflect, and celebrate through the gift of music. May these offerings encourage our hearts and draw us closer to God as together we lift our voices in praise.
