Adopt-A-Class...if you or your Sunday School class are interested in adopting a St. Lillian Academy class room please contact Felicia in the church office.

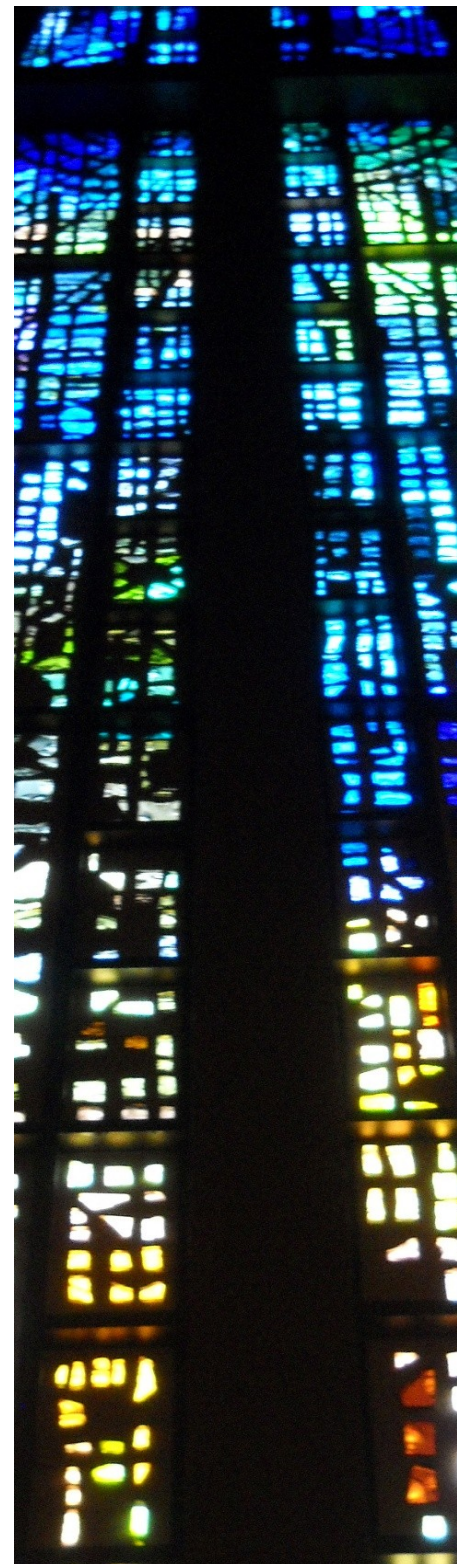
Bag of Hope...Together for Hope Louisiana is looking for donations for this year's Bags of Hope through Amazon (amzn.to/3oxsCCz).
