This past Sunday, our church choir sang one of my favorite choral songs, “I Believe.” Maybe it’s the haunting and mystical way Caelyn sang the solo part? Maybe it’s the way Mel plays the piano? Maybe it’s the lyrics which many times I feel like I can relate to? Maybe it’s the story behind the lyrics that I referred to? Maybe it’s the setting of our beautiful Sanctuary?

The lyrics are simple... “I believe in the sun, even when it’s not shining. I believe in love, even when I don’t feel it. I believe in God, even when God is silent.” These lyrics are based on a poem found carved on a cellar wall in Germany where Jewish people hid during the Holocaust. “I believe in the sun even when it is not shining. Think of the mindset, the feeling with the heart, the faith of the person who originally wrote these lines on a dark cellar wall during one of the dark times in the history of the world. This song is just simply powerful!

Step inside this endless moment for a subtle touch of grace, I've always found my strength inside the act of faith.
