"An Essay About Broadmoor"

In her English Class, Maddie Robinson was tasked with writing a profile for a place that was very meaningful to her. I hope you will find it as inspiring as it was to me.

"Broadmoor Baptist Church (BBC) has always felt like a second home to me. The smiles of people surrounding me since birth, with open welcoming arms fill a special place in my heart. I've grown up in this church, making lifelong friends and having an unlimited amount of memories. The moment I walk into the doors for church youth group, I immediately lighten up and feel weight just drop off of me. My friends here are like no other, and we all just fit together so perfectly. My youth group is much smaller than many others, meaning my connections with them are just so much stronger and deeper. As soon as I walk in the doors I can hear my friends joyfully yelling my name and coming to give me hugs, even though the majority of them saw me just that same morning at church service. Bobby is also part of this key moment. He provides all of us with a fun time, while also giving us a safe space in him. This moment continues to occur each Sunday, and it just motivates me to continue having such a strong connection with this church and its people.
